#### MINUTE FOR MISSION FOR MAY

For Outreach Sunday on May 30<sup>th</sup> our speaker will be Mr. Jacques Lapointe from GRID & NEA. GRID is "Ghana Rural Integrated Development" and NEA is "Northern Empowerment Association". These charities have several projects underway in Northern Ghana under sponsorship from ECAC or Evangelical Christ Apostolic Church which is registered as a Charity in Milton ON Canada. Their mission is to assist poor communities to meet their needs in a sustainable manner. Their motivation is Jesus Christ's love.

Initially over many years they established 46 congregations in northern Ghana and built them churches while also helping the people in their towns and villages to make their lives better. At present the big project is enlarging the Leyaata Hospital in the town of Carpenter with opening later in 2021: http://hospital.grid-nea.org

Also underway at present is a project to improve Maternal and Newborn care which has already dramatically reduced the infant mortality rate in those towns. Also there are several projects to help local people to establish agricultural industries, like egg and boiler hen production and aquaculture. The list of projects is astounding and very practical.
